

## Proposal to establish the Pioneer Trust

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the Governing Body of Andrew Marvell Business & Enterprise College intends to make a prescribed alteration to Andrew Marvell Business & Enterprise College, Barham Road, Hull HU9 4EE. The proposed alteration is to Change School Category from Community to Foundation and Acquire a Foundation established otherwise than under the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 from 07 September 2008.

The reason for the change is to move the College forward in providing a partnership that will devote itself to raising Community aspirations through valuing Education and thereby embedding lifelong learning and lifelong earning in the Community that will enable regeneration and therefore benefit all members of the Community.

The name of the foundation will be The Pioneer Trust. The proposed Trust members are: Primary school partners; Bellfield Primary School; Griffin Primary School; Longhill Primary School; Spring Cottage Primary School; Thanet Primary School; Wansbeck Primary School; Hull Primary Care Trust; Wilberforce College; Hull University Business School; Hull College; Community Farm; SureStart; Co-operative Group; Co-operative College; AMBEC; East Hull Community; PROBE and the Local Authority.
